Whether your preference is lounging on the beach, dining with the sea breeze on your face or diving in to enjoy the water, Surfside has something for you.

With its four miles of unspoiled shoreline, Surfside Beach is a perfect retreat for recreational sport enthusiasts, fishermen, sun worshippers and nature lovers alike. This gem, located on the shores of the Gulf of Mexico, promises a wide array of recreational activities.

With shoreline to the south and wetland that abuts the Intracoastal Waterway to the north, fishing is abundant. Offshore fishing is offered through local charter and marine services, or can be accessed from boat ramps. Surfside Beach also has two marinas. For those who prefer to stay on land, Surfside Jetty Park provides a paved jetty alongside the Freeport ship channel. The jetty offers Gulf fishing without the boat, and many people like to surf fish as well.

Nature lovers will have plenty of opportunity for bird watching and viewing the natural habitat that this estuary offers. Surfside was just named "Bird City" by Texas Parks and Wildlife. This unique honor is because of our 400 species of birds and a beautiful habitat called the Surfside Bird & Butterfly Trail at 418 Parkview. Surfside was also awarded the title of Monarch Designation. Visitors can walk over 1 mile of trails to enjoy their bird and butterfly sightings.

Those coming to enjoy nature will be drawn to the crown jewel of Surfside -- the beach. The Pedestrian Beach runs along the revetment wall on Beach Drive. Surfers along with kayakers, windsurfers and Boogie boarders love this area. Want a piece of the action? Locally owned shops provide watersports equipment. There is also a portion of Surfside's beach that's accessible to vehicles via an annual paid permit that funds beach maintenance.

When you find that one day isn't enough, vacation rentals, hotels and RV parks are available across the island. Whether you need space for a large group or prefer an intimate cottage, there are accommodations to fit your needs.

While on vacation, enjoy a variety of restaurants offering fresh seafood and island specialties. And be sure to check out the active night life. Whatever you choose, you're sure to have a great time only an hour's drive from Houston.
